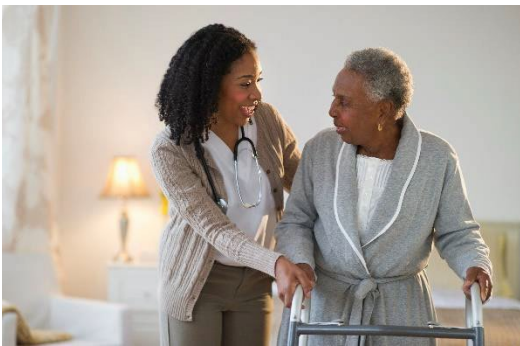




Older Adult Medi-Cal Expansion

Starting May 1, 2022, all Alameda County residents who are 50 years of age or older and meet all Medi-Cal eligibility criteria will be able to get full coverage Medi-Cal, regardless of immigration status!



What is full coverage Medi-Cal?

Medi-Cal is a public health insurance program which provides free or low-cost health care services to qualified California residents.

Full coverage Medi-Cal includes:

- Emergency health care
- Routine check-ups
- Medical, dental, mental health, family planning, and vision (eye) care
- Substance abuse treatment
- Prescriptions



Additional benefits include transportation to and from the doctor, dental, and pharmacy visits for prescription pick-up. A primary care doctor can also provide specialty medical referrals if needed.



Enrollment in a Medi-Cal health plan provides access to a network of doctors that cover an array of medical services.

I am 50 or older (or will be in May 2022). What do I need to do?

If you are 50 years of age or older and have restricted coverage or emergency Medi-Cal, you will automatically get full coverage Medi-Cal starting May 1, 2022.

If you are 50 years of age or older or will turn 50 at any time in May 2022 and do NOT have Medi-Cal coverage of any kind, you may be eligible for full coverage Medi-Cal beginning May 1, 2022.

If you are under 49 ½ as of June 1, 2022 or after, you may be eligible for restricted coverage Medi-Cal. Once you turn 50, you will start receiving full coverage Medi-Cal without having to apply again.
