#### **Findings to Continue Meeting by Teleconference:**

Staff Recommendation: Find that 1) the Alameda County Commission on the Status of Women has reconsidered the circumstances of the state of emergency, and 2) state or local officials continue to impose or recommend measures to promote social distancing. This recommendation follows the 09/28/2021 County Board of Supervisors' adoption of the Health Care Services Agency Director's recommendation that the Board implement social distancing for its meetings. For the same reasons, the same rationale applies for the meetings of the Alameda County Commission on the Status of Women and its committees.
