1. Event

Over the summer Chair Amey and Commissioner Senn met with the leadership of the Association of California Commissions for Women (ACCW). A discussion regarding funds received by ACCW to help commissions around the state yielded a desire for the commissions to work together as a unified body to help strengthen our voices for the causes identified and pursued by the commissions, specifically the Committee on the Elimination of Discrimination against Women (CEDAW).

Our nation is one of 6 nations that have not ratified CEDAW. It is an International Humans Right Treaty focused on eliminating discrimination against women in all areas i.e., equal pay, violence, support for families and caregivers and more.

Berkeley is the only city in the county that has already ratified CEDAW. Chair Amey asked if COSW would be interested in sending a delegation to the state convening. Commissioners Scott, Senn, Welch, Bharoocha-Jobe. Kreeger and Walker volunteered to attend.

Commissioner Scott offered to bring some additional knowledge and background information regarding CEDAW and it's standing within Alameda County and beyond to the commission.

Commissioner Bharoocha-Jobe addressed the possibility of including a discussion on the 2022 budgetary needs for women recovering from COVID-19 at the convening.

Commissioner Gilmore motioned to send a delegation, seconded by Commissioner Senn. Motion Passed

Commissioner Scott offered to reach out to someone on the Berkeley's Commission to chat and possibly get more information about CEDAW. Commissioner Kazmi offered to support this effort now that she is in Berkeley.

Chair Amey will be meeting with Nancy from Santa Clara County commission to discuss CEDAW to gather more knowledge.
