-Chair Mojadedi thanks Vice Chair Khan for stepping in while he has been out -Chair Mojadedi suggested HRC does not have a retreat in this FY but host it in July instead so funds can be reallocated

-Next meeting discussion will be around spending down remaining budget

Treasurer's Report:

-Received approved budget from Social Services \$6,850 (HRC had budgeted for \$11,650) -HRC Luncheon got reduced from \$3,000 to \$2,000

-YTD \$1,228.33 Spent (16% of the budget)

-YTD left to spend \$5,221.67

-Requested: \$1,000 for swag and \$1,000 for the Luncheon to be reallocated

-Motion by Commissioner Sandhu to reallocated funds from HRC retreat to move to HRC in Excellence Awards, seconded by Commissioner Dwin. Motion passed unanimously

Staff Report:

-Kim stated that HRC can request a budget increase depending on the need -Sylvia Director of Public Affairs:

- In the process at looking at all the budgets, is to look at the actual spending (\$10k is usually that target number)
- If there is a line item to add that is not included in the budget, HRC can submit to Social Services to augment
- The goal was never meant to meet a benchmark of \$10k/it is whatever the Commission is spending every year
- Looking at the HRC budget, there was no justification for the spending
- Vice Chair Khan stated that HRC has traditionally spend \$6,500k assuming that is the budget HRC has to work with
- The shaded area on the HRC Approved budget were funded by Supervisor Valle
