To promote the economic and social well being of individuals, families, neighborhoods and communities.



Our agency is comprised of over 2,300 individuals working collectively and in partnership with community based organizations to serve the needs of the community.






Child Welfare Children and Non-Minor Dependent Youth in Cases




Child Welfare Children and Non-Minor Dependent Out-Of-Home Placements



AB 12: Child Welfare Non-Minor Dependent Youth 18+ in Placement by Placement Type





Child Welfare Children 0 - 17 in Placement by Placement Type



The California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids (CaWORKs) Program provides time-limited cash aid, employment and employment support services to eligible adults with children.



General Assistance (GA) provides cash aid to indigent adults and emancipated minors who are legal residents of Alameda County and who have no other means of support.







Adult Protective Services



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In-Home Supportive Services

IHSS provides homecare for the elderly and persons with disabilities to support them in their own homes and communities, rather than placing them in more restrictive and expensive institutional care settings.


